NOTES

- 1. The dates correspond to Ramadan 2016 (June 6—July 5), but you can use this calendar any time of year.
- 2. Click on the country name to get more information on that country, including statistics, ministries, prayer cards, videos, links to other research and prayer sites, and much more.
- 3. This number corresponds to all Joshua Project peoples in that country. For a discussion concerning "What is a people group?", click here. For an attempt to answer the question "How many people groups are there?", click here. A list of Joshua Project data sources can be found here.
- 4. This number corresponds to the number of Joshua Project unreached (least-reached) people groups for a given country. An unreached people group is "a people group within which there is no indigenous community of believing Christians able to evangelize this people group" without outside assistance (Winter, Ralph D., et al., eds. *Perspectives on the World Christian Movement: Reader.* William Carey Library Pub, 2009, pg. 536). Click here for a discussion of how the Joshua Project defines UPGs (unreached people groups).
- 5. Click on the name of the people group (e.g., Arab, Moroccan) for more information on that group.
- 6. An estimate of the population of a particular people group within a given country. In many cases peoples may be found in several countries, in which case the global number can be much higher.
- 7. The estimated number of Christians (of any description) within a particular people group in a given country. Space limitations prevent us from giving global numbers across all countries; those estimates can be found on joshuaproject.net. In all cases, the peoples on this calendar are less than 3% Christian.
- 8. The estimated number of Evangelical Christians within a particular people group in a particular country. In all cases, the peoples here are less than 2% Evangelical. *Note that these numbers are rounded at two places of the decimal.* Thus, 0.00% Evangelical doesn't necessarily mean zero Evangelicals. In a population of 10 million people, 49,999 believers would 0.00%, while 50,000 would be 0.01%.
