Has the month flown by for you like it has for me? I look at my calendar and think, "Really? It's September already?"

Last month, I asked you to think and pray about anyone you know who would be interested in knowing more about Bibles & Literature in French and my year as an intern. I have made some wonderful new contacts – and made wonderful new friends already! Thank you for praying. ☺

The good news is:

God supplied more than the 75% of my support that I needed to start the visa paperwork!

So, it's in the works. Here we go! But there are a lot of pieces to put together. It's a long process. Well, it's just a longer process than I would like.

In the midst of starting the visa, a few things needed to be changed. The first was the discovery of a few additional costs: health insurance and an additional

Residence Permit fee. Both are required if I am going to live in France, so \$942 has been added to the budget to cover the extra cost. Even with this increase, God has brought donations that cover the extra costs! It is truly a miracle only God could accomplish.

The other change is this: Due to the processing time for the visa, I won't be able to get to France during the month of September. If all goes well, I will leave in early/mid October. But, that gives me a few extra weeks to see old friends, meet new ones, and tell everyone about the ministry of Bibles & Literature in French! It's one last push for a full 100%. Plus, I get to go to the Kern County Fair at the end of September!
